

## JALAPEÑO CHEESEBURGERS – 30 MINUTES

|---------------------------------------|-------------------------------------|
| 1 lb lean ground beef                 | ¼ cup shredded Monterey Jack cheese |
| 2 tsp seeded, chopped jalapeño pepper | 4 thin tomato slices                |
| 1½ tsp Mexican seasoning              | 4 hamburger buns, split, toasted    |

1. In medium bowl, combine ground beef, jalapeño pepper and Mexican seasoning, mixing lightly but thoroughly. Shape into four ½" thick patties.
2. Place patties on grid over medium ash-covered coals. Grill uncovered 14 to 16 minutes or until centers are no longer pink, turning once. Approximately 1 minute before burgers are done, sprinkle each with 1 Tbsp cheese.
3. Place one slice tomato on bottom half of each bun; top with burger. Close sandwiches. **4 servings.**
