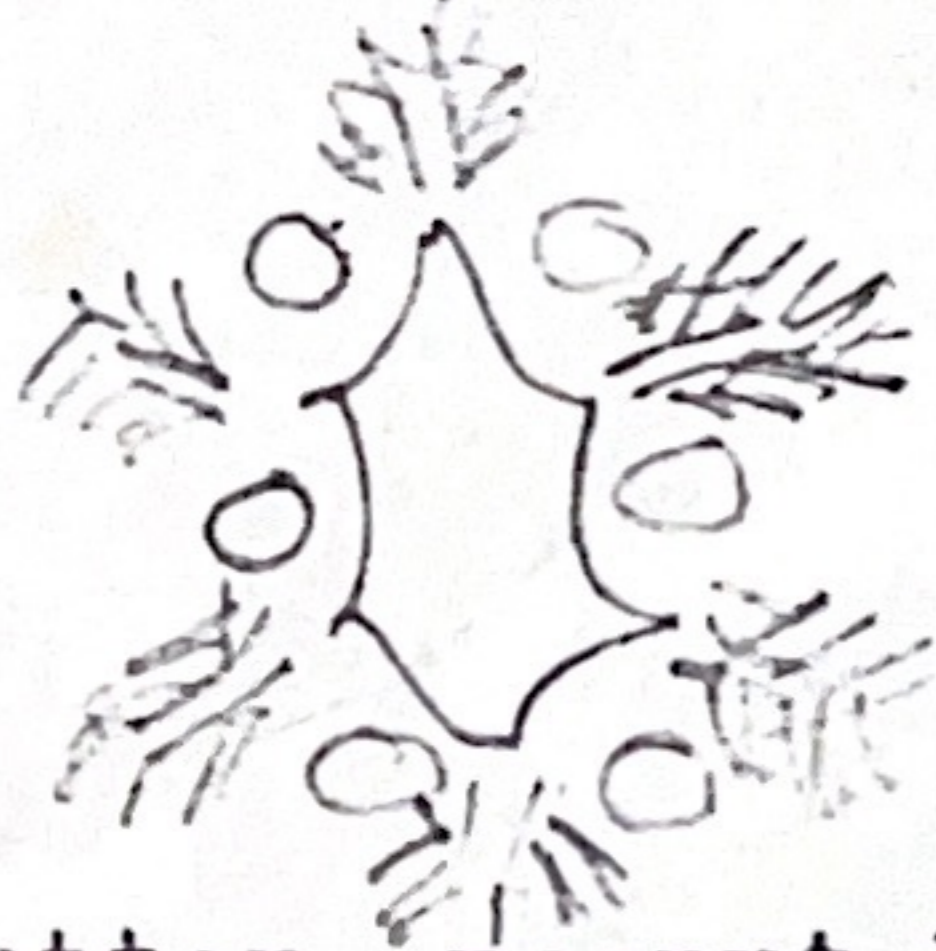




PEANUT BUTTER BALLS

Here's a fantastic recipe that tastes just like the peanut butter cups you purchase in the store! And, this recipe makes "lots" so you'll have enough for family and gift-giving. For an extra special gift, fill the Egg Tray with these little Peanut Butter Balls and just top with a bow!!! NOTE - these candies freeze well in your Tupperware



1 lb. butter (not margarine)

3 lbs. powdered sugar

3" piece of paraffin

2lbs. creamy peanut butter

2 lg. packages of chocolate chips

Mix butter, peanut butter and powdered sugar well in the large Mixing Bowl. Form in small balls and place on a cookie sheet in the fridge to chill while preparing the chocolate mixture. Next, melt chocolate and paraffin in a double broiler. Insert a toothpick into the peanut butter balls to dip them into the hot chocolate mixture, place on a piece of wax paper until the chocolate sets. When cooled, place the candy in your favorite piece of Tupperware for storing or gift-giving. Store in the refrigerator, really delicious!
